There continues to be a pending legal matter. Due to a court decision last week, we will have to pause. The county and legal teams are briefing and weighing out potential options to provide direction moving forward. Will provide an update at the next meeting.

D. MAC Update	Michelle Hatfield	 June 27, 2024 - Specialty Care Programs, Pediatric Advisory Committee is partnering with Loma Linda Hospital to visit local hospitals that aren't specialized for pediatrics, so they have the readiness and can assess gaps. They have sent out a survey to evaluate any gaps with pediatric care in the field. Two new LOSOP Ultrasound for Prehospital and Prehospital Blood Transfusions The next MAC meeting is October 24, 2024.
E. Ambulance Ordinance	Amber Anaya	 August 6-2024, we submitted a portion of our ordinances to the board to ensure we are complying with AB716 to set the max ambulance rate. We also updated some of the language regarding public health and added a more generalization that refers to our policy for ambulance rates. Passed on August 20, 2024. Update the whole ordinances starting at the beginning of the year.
