| | Current State of EMS | Phase 2 feedback was reviewed; data was inaccurate (i.e. how many calls each agency was tracking, what data source consultants were using, etc.) Anna will do a follow up to see what reports are available. Discussion about lack of EMS in Olancha. Questions included: Who is responsible for notifying the public and other agencies about the lack of local EMS response in the community? Liberty Ambulance attempted to put an auto-aid agreement in place with Olancha, but the process was not completed. They stated that it interferes with their normal service area and creates financial strain. They will soon stop responding to mutual aid requests if there is no financial support to continue. What is the legality for Fire Depts to respond to EMS page without EMS providers? Sierra Lifeflight, Lone Pine Fire, and SIH offered training for EMTs and mentorship through their departments.
