SUBJECT: IMAGE TREND MIGRATION SCHEDULE

ICEMA is pleased to announce a significant step in our digital transformation campaign as we prepare to migrate Image Trend data from traditional hardware servers to a cloud based hosted environment. This transformation will increase uptime speeds, improve security and streamline maintenance and scalability.

To ensure a smooth transition and minimize any disruption, we have scheduled the following migration phases:

• Patient Registry:

Date: March 13, 2024Duration: Up to 4 hours

o **Impact:** Website will be unavailable, no uploads of Trauma, STEMI, or Stroke data during this period.

• Licensure:

Date: March 27, 2024Duration: Up to 4 hours

o **Impact:** Website will be unavailable, and credentialing activities will pause. Processing of applications will resume upon system restoration.

• Elite/Continuum:

Date: April 10, 2024Duration: Up to 8 hours

o **Impact:** Website will be unavailable, direct data entry will not be possible. Tablet-based ePCR creation is allowed, but submission will be delayed until the outage ends.
