	D. POCUS	POCUS has gone live, and Corona Regional has received field ultrasounds and giving reviews. Cloud is fully operational with HIPAA compliance. We are limited to 65 Butterfly cloud accounts for approved paramedics. If you are interested in obtaining an account for your paramedic(s), please reach out to Dr. V., or Jeff Copeland. VVFD is currently training their paramedics and is expecting to go live in a week or two with their devices. VVC is interested in getting more exposure and education for paramedic students with Butterfly device. If anyone is interested in assisting them, please reach out.	Reza Vaezazizi
	E. EMS BUP	There has been a total of 10 suboxone administrations in the region. Paramedics provide assessments and COW scores to qualifying patients. AMR has launched in Victorville but currently has no administrations.	Reza Vaezazizi
	F. Blood Products-Postpartum Hemorrhage	Corona Fire has 3 administrations and 1 missed transfusion in. Across state, things are moving forward. There have been 15 transfusions in each LA area. The number of transfusions in LACo is credited to their expanded criteria. EMSA's Trauma Summit in San Diego and CA Fire Chiefs Conference in Anaheim will help spread the word for blood. 	I. Amiodarone Use for Refractory Ventricular	AHA recommends the use of Amio. LACo, OC, Riv. Co. are using Amio. It is suggested that San Bernardino County	Patricia Eickholt

	Fibrillation and Pulseless Ventricular Tachycardia	adopt it too. The proposal to incorporate Amio was presented to EMS Officers. To gather necessary supporting data, the topic will be escalated for discussion at the next CQILT meeting. Dr. V. specifically suggested comparing CARES data from Riv. Co. and SBCo to evaluate the difference in survivability between Amio and Epi in cardiac arrest protocols.	
	J. Public Comment Period	Concerns were raised regarding both the optimal muscle group for TXA administration and the current limitations of the IM dose. The available TXA formulation is 100 mg/1 ml (1,000 mg/10 ml) vials, which does not support the intended 2 g IM administration. This issue will be resolved and a standardized protocol agreed upon at the October MAC meeting.	All
