	1. Pediatric AC	PAC met today and they are doing great work through the subcommittee by going through all the policies to clarify language on ages. With the collaboration with physicians, they are having great conversations to improve pediatric care. PAC meets again in January, and then they will be meeting quarterly. 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	D. Inyo/ Mono County Updates	No one on call to provide Inyo/Mono Update	Lisa Davis/Jessica Wagner
	E. POCUS	Corona Fire, San Bernardino County Fire, Rialto Fire, and Victorville Fire are all live and uploading images to the cloud. Corona Fire has uploaded 10 images for 10 patients, and SB County Fire has uploaded 18. The positions of the images have provided good feedback. All calls are 100% CQI. Next meeting scheduled for first week of December where providers will give updates and plans for improvement.	Jeff Copeland
	F. EMS BUP	4 agencies are administering Suboxone, with AMR Victorville being the newest. AMR went live in September. There have been 16 Suboxone administrations since the program started. No adverse events and all calls are 100% CQI.	Jeff Copeland
	G. Blood Products-Postpartum Hemorrhage	Ontario Fire will be launching shortly. They are still pending final approval for their program and almost everything is in order. There are still a couple of agencies interested in the program: San Bernardino County Fire, Rancho Cucamonga Fire, and Victorville Fire. They are still at various levels in acquiring equipment and contracting with blood banks. Something to be worked on is mutual aid agreements for agencies to provide resources to neighboring jurisdictions. Issues have been identified with Delta APRU which agencies and Delta are working together to find solutions. Exploring the possibility of whole blood providers to partner with trauma centers to rotate whole blood and reduce potential waste. Corona Fire has recycled about 100 units with Life Stream and 2-3 units being wasted. 2 units wasted to being spiked and patient falling outside of eligibility, and 1 due to APRU failure.
