## NAUSEA AND VOMITING

### I. FIELD ASSESSMENT/TREATMENT INDICATORS

- Nausea.
- Vomiting.
- Prophylactic treatment of narcotic induced nausea and/or vomiting.

### II. CONTRAINDICATIONS

**Patients under four (4) years of age.**

Known sensitivity to Ondansetron or other 5-HT<sub>3</sub> antagonists:

- Granisetron (Kytril)
- Dolasetron (Anzemet)
- Palonosetron (Aloxi)

### III. ALS INTERVENTIONS

- Assess patient for need for anti-emetic therapy.
- Maintain airway.
- Position of comfort.
- Oxygen.
- Cardiac monitoring in patients with history of cardiac problems.
- Ondansetron per ICEMA Reference #11010 - Medication - Standard Orders.
